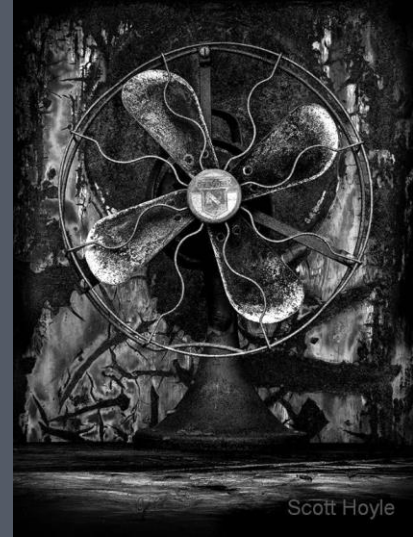
*Has Its Rewards*
